Whether you are struggling with custody issues, wondering what community support is available, or just looking to connect with other grandparents or relative caregivers, we can help.

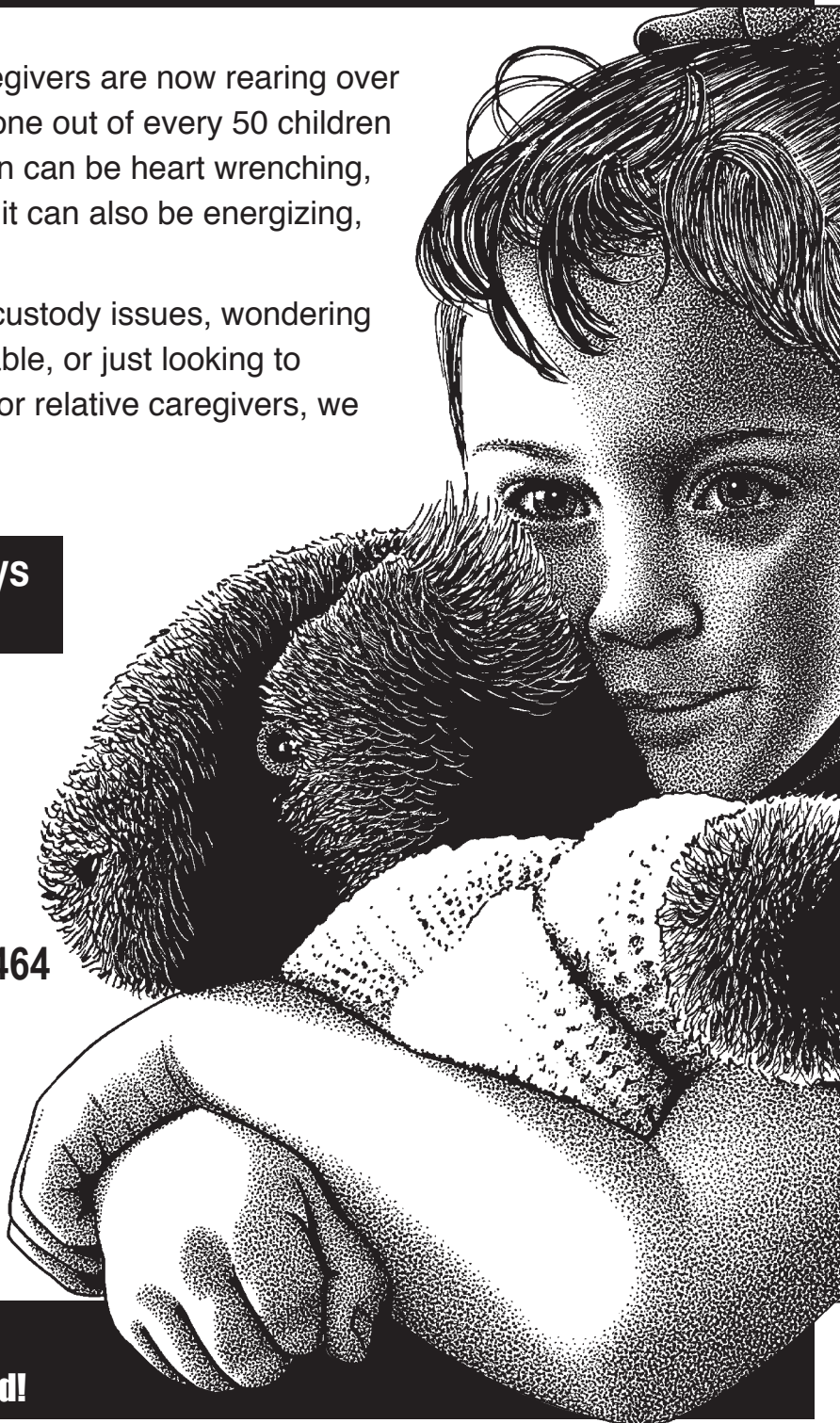
